- **2.)** Two (2) letters of recommendation attesting to your character and achievements with at least one (1) from a guidance counselor or teacher. Provide the full name, title and email address for each person who will submit a letter of recommendation. **EMAIL TO: SCHOLARSHIP@UPSILONTAUOMEGA.ORG**
- **3.)** Write an Essay "Discuss a relevant issue that you are extremely passionate about." Submission should be no more than 500 words, double-spaced using 12 point Times New Romanfont.

- **4)** Resume that includes: work experience, volunteer experience, community service experience, extracurricular activities, membership in organizations, educational and career goals and special achievements/accomplishments.

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCEDURES

All Scholarship Applicants must:

- Be a resident of or attend school in Southern Prince George's County Legislative District 8 or 9
- Be a graduating high school senior
- Be planning to attend a 2 or 4-year institution of higher learning
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or above

Submit by Postal Mail

•An official transcript. (For current high school seniors, transcript must include grades 9-11). The transcript must cite the cumulative grade point average and must be signed by a school official with the official school seal in a sealed envelope.

- Typed essay no more than 500 words addressing topic as outlined on the current application.
- Provide the full name, title and email address for each person who will submit a letter of recommendation.

Letters of Recommendation (Submitted by email from person writing letter)

Identify Applicant in the Subject Line. Persons writing recommendations should specify relationship or capacity in which they know or have observed the applicant.

- (1) one current (2017/2018) signed letter of recommendation from non-school related **community service or job/volunteer** related activity that you participated in on the organization's letterhead.
- (1) one current (2017/2018) signed letter of recommendation from the **school** (i.e. teacher, principal, counselor etc.) on official school letterhead.
